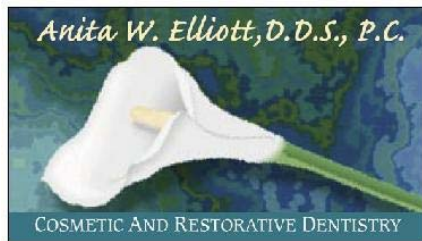

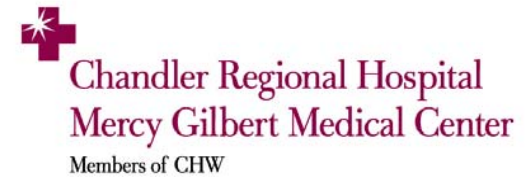

Edgar H. Hernandez M.D., F.I.C.S., F.A.C.S.

In private practice since June of 1983, Dr. Hernandez has focused in the past few years on breast cancer. With the new treatment modalities available to patients at this time, it has been challenging and exciting to participate in the diagnosis, surgery and treatment of breast cancer patients. Of particular interest has been the MammoSite 5-day targeted radiation therapy.

Doctor Hernandez is also well known for his humanitarian efforts with his Reach Mexico organization which provides medical equipment and services to the poor in the country.

He is past Chief of Staff, Vice Chief of Staff and Chief of Surgery at Chandler Regional Hospital and has served as a preceptor for Midwestern University and Kirksville College for several years.

Dr. Hernandez has served as Chief Medical Advisor for the Desert Cancer Foundation for the past several years. He is the major sponsor of today's luncheon.

Eric Olyejar, MD

Dr. Olyejar is Board Certified in Radiation Oncology and joined ICRC in 2006. He graduated summa cum laude with a B.S. in analytical chemistry from the University of Northern Colorado, and then received his M.D. with honors, from the University of Colorado. Dr. Olyejar completed specialty training in Charleston, SC at the Medical University of South Carolina, where he served as chief resident for 2 years.

Dr. Olyejar specializes in the treatment of cancer of the breast, prostate, and head and neck. He is experienced and has special training and interest in brachytherapy for all sites including breast (MammoSite and Multiplanar techniques), prostate (Seeds and HDR), head and neck, gynecologic, esophagus, skin and lung. Dr. Olyejar was recently featured on national television for his unique breast brachytherapy technique.

Nicole Crites, Guest Emcee Morning and Afternoon News Anchor, CBS 5

Nicole Crites co-anchors the CBS Morning News with Mike Chamberlin weekdays from 4:30-7:00 am.

Award winning and Emmy nominated for her breaking news and feature reports, Nicole joined KPHO as a general assignment reporter in December 2004. A Tucson native, she returns to Arizona from anchoring mornings and reporting for KREM, the CBS affiliate in Spokane, Washington.

She's worked the big stories, from the verdict to bankrupt the Aryan Nations, to the Deaths of 4 forest service firefighters in Washington's 30 Mile Fire and live reports from Manhattan after 9/11.

When she's not working, Nicole spends her time exploring the valley with her husband, reading, running and quilting. She comes from a family of 6 kids and has a Rottweiler that looks more like a horse than a dog. Nicole has a passion for storytelling and loves meeting new people every day. She believes everyone has a story.

Gary Cruz: Weekend Sports Anchor, CBS 5

CBS 5 News sports anchor Gary Cruz began his anchoring career in 1974 at KUSA-TV in Denver and was a sports anchor in Los Angeles for nine years. Gary is also known for his radio work as sports talk host at XTRA in Los Angeles and hosts his own show, the Positive Side of Sports, on ESPN Radio 860, KMVP. He was also a color commentator for the Denver Broncos pre-season football as well as the Denver Gold of the USFL. While in Denver, Gary hosted the John Elway Show on KMGH-TV, and in Los Angeles was the host of the Lakers pre-game show on KCAL-TV.

During his career, Gary has won 2 Emmys for his sports reporting and show hosting as well as an IRIS Award for documentary work. He's also been honored by the Associated Press for reporting, commentary and anchoring. Since moving to the valley, Gary has joined the board of the Arizona Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Gary is married and has a college-aged son.

Laura Fial

Singing and classically trained since the age of 6, Laura is now a seasoned 20+ year professional vocalist and entertainer in Phoenix, Arizona. Her project work and vocals gained national recognition with a recent Grammy nomination in 2004 for her work on "Soul Survivors Flight for Lifers".

Extremely active in the local communities, Laura has been nominated for, and been presented awards to include: Community Hero's of Scottsdale, Voices Against Cancer, Spirit of Women, and the Hello Tomorrow Fund for Women.

Her weekly local performance venues include The Wine List, Piccazzo's, and Eddie V's Restaurant. She is always available as a vocalist and entertainment resource specializing in 2-5 piece ensembles, jazz, and contemporary performances for private, corporate, and fundraising events.
